HMSHOST MAKES NASHVILLE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT A DINING DESTINATION

Debuts Popular Local and National Brands

The 11-year contract to develop new food and beverage venues, awarded to HMSHost Corporation by the Metropolitan Nashville Airport Authority in August 2006, marks HMSHost's first Nashville operation.

Now open in the C Concourse Food Court are local favorite Baja Burrito along with nationally known brands Famous Famiglia Pizzeria, Quiznos Subs and Burger King.

Other delectable dining options will be available to Nashville travelers with the completion of phases two and three, including two Starbucks Coffee locations, Nashville Delicatessen, Tennessee Tavern, Neely's Barbeque, Gibson's Guitar Café and Provence Breads & Café. Construction on phase two is set to begin in October of 2007 with completion in January 2008. Phase three construction will run from November 2008 to January 2009.

"With the opening of the new C Concourse Food Court, Nashville passengers now have the exceptional restaurant brands they recognize and appreciate, courtesy of HMSHost," said Raul Regalado, President and CEO of the Metropolitan Nashville Airport Authority. "Early indications are that Nashville travelers are very pleased with these new options."
